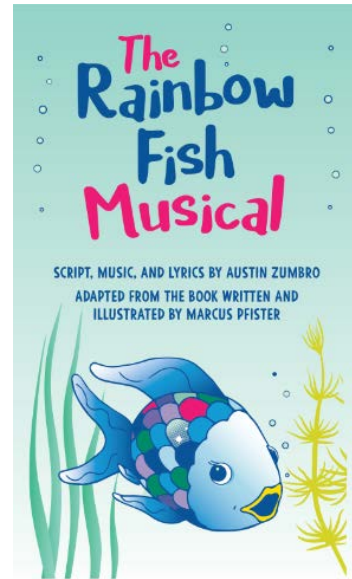
Mrs. Anna Boughner, teacher, who has completed all Spiritual Journey components needed to be a certified Catechist in the Diocese of Erie.

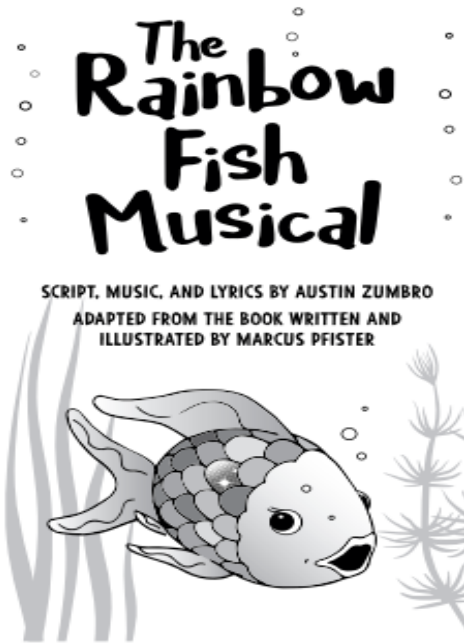
