2019-2020 FACTS MANAGEMENT

Current Families that have payments for the 2018-2019 school year will be rolled-over to the 2019-2020 school year. There is a \$42 fee from FACTS Management.

Tuition Agreements for the 2019-2020 school year have payments scheduled for either 11 months (Aug. 2019 through June 2020) or 10 months (Sept. 2019 through June 2020), unless other tuition payment arrangements have been made. There will be an annual \$42 fee assigned by FACTS Management to your first payment.

What is the EAC?

Saint Michael School has a nine member council that meets monthly from August to June whose purpose is to:

- Serve as an advisory council assisting the Pastor and Principal in the administration of the parish grade school subject to such regulations that may proceed from the Diocese of Erie or the Catholic Schools Office.
- Accept the responsibility of providing the students of Saint Michael School with the highest quality of education consistent with parish capabilities.
- Conduct all business falling within the framework of the duties and functions of the council during an official council meeting.

Each member of the council serves a 3-year term which may be renewed.
